Constructions

Subject + would (not) + like to + Base Form + ...

(QW) + would + subject + like to + Base Form + ... ?

Speaking – Use would like to + BF

A: Would you like to ...?

B: Yes. + [add information]

No. + [tell your wishes]

What about you?

A: [Tell your wishes]

Listening

What **would** the speaker **like to do**?

- 1) She who?

Speaking – lead in

- 1) Read and understand the alternatives.
- 2) Check (✓) if YES or cross (×) if NOT
- 3) If YES, write one word of extra information: when, where, who, what
- 3) If NOT, write one word of extra information: problem, reason, etc.

Speaking – Compare your charts with would like to + BF

A: Would you like to _____ ?

B: Yes, I would. I'd like to ... + [add info]

A: Me too! I'd like to ... + [add info]

A: Well, not me. I wouldn't like to ... + [add info]

A: Would you like to _____ ?

B: No, I wouldn't. + [add info]

A: Me neither. + [add info]

A: Well, not me. I would like to ... + [add info]

Listening

Answer **yes** or **no**.
